The cardiologist has dismissed the pacemaker as the cause and on Tuesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> May he had a CAT scan. Thank the Lord nothing was detected but in some ways we were hoping something would be found. So the next step is our going to St. Vincents Hospital in Sydney where three tests will be conducted. Yes, another trip to Sydney! These tests are (1) a hearing test, (2) an Electrocochleography test and (3) an Electronystagmography test. They say to do all the tests will take between three to four hours. The tests are scheduled for June 13 at 10am so this means driving down the 12<sup>th</sup> and coming home the 14<sup>th</sup>. Hopefully the tests will expose the problem and a solution will be given. The noise in the left ear is getting more extreme and more often. With all these trips to Sydney we are glad we had the timing belt replaced in the car when we did as it does give some peace of mind when travelling on the road. Pam had her post operation check the 15<sup>th</sup> in Sydney with the surgeon and all is healing as it should. We do have a lot to thank the Lord for!

Thank you again for your continued prayers and financial support. We know it is not always easy for some of our supporters either as you also have physical and financial trials. However, it truly is an encouragement to know *“he knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold”* Job 23:10. Note the word *“shall”*.
