

Merv had a heart attack and stroke which of course landed him in hospital. I visited him in hospital and took him the booklet **ULTIMATE QUESTIONS** by John Blanchard. He is now out of hospital and dropped by the studio on my Friday programme to thank me for the visit. Also our seventy five year old neighbour, **Bob** has had several strokes and recently fell which put him in hospital. I visited Bob the same day I visited Merv. I also left **ULTIMATE QUESTIONS** with Bob and trust his wife may read it to him as his ability to read is null and void now. Bob and his wife are atheists. We pray the Lord may work in Bob and Lynne's hearts before it is too late.

Thank you for your continued prayers and support. The Lord has been so very good to us through the years and we thank Him for allowing us to serve here.
